The 36th running of the \$1 million Arlington Million (G1) will take place on Saturday, with a strong field of 11 set to go postward. Multiple Grade 1 winner OSCAR PERFORMANCE draws widest but is the one to beat. Classy colt from the barn of Brian Lynch was a fine winner in his seasonal bow when dominating the Poker H. (G3) at Belmont Park. And he likes this turf course as well, proven by his sterling tally in the 2017 Secretariat (G1).

Four-time Group 1 hero ROBERT BRUCE suffered his first setback in the Manhattan (G1) on Belmont Day when beaten by one length. Classy four-year-old endured traffic in that event and has trained forwardly since in preparation of a third run on U. S. soil. Chad Brown pupil will likely sit a good trip a few lengths off of a solid tempo and get first run on the deep closers in the stretch. Irad Ortiz has the assignment.

DEAUVILLE finished third in the 2016 Arlington Million. He was a head second in his final prep for the 2017 Arlington Million, and then finished third by three-parts of a length at Arlington. The five-year-old son of Galileo was a neck second in that same prep last month in advance of the 2018 Million. Aidan O'Brien trainee is not the type that wins a lot but I can't dispute his class.
