KEENELAND SPRING MEET by John Mucciolo

The much-anticipated spring meet at Keeneland Race Course will get underway on Thursday, April 4 and run through April 26. The Lexington, Kentucky venue is arguably the most attractive spring horse racing destination in the United States, bringing out hoards of race goers as well as top athletes from across the nation.

A total of 18 graded events worth in excess of \$4 million will be held at Keeneland with eight occurring during opening weekend. The \$150,000 Transylvania Stakes (G3) for sophomores on the lawn will kick off the graded action on Friday, April 5. A full and talented cast is expected for this year's edition.

Saturday, April 6 is the signature day of the spring meeting and is led by the \$1 million Blue Grass Stakes (G2). This Road to the Kentucky Derby series event is a 1 1/8 miles event for three-year-old Kentucky Derby (G1) hopefuls, and it always features some of the top sophomores in training. This important stakes contest was taken by Good Magic in 2018, and he parlayed his Keeneland success into a runner-up finish in the Kentucky Derby.

The top draw on the Blue Grass undercard on Saturday is the \$500,000 Ashland Stakes (G1). This Road to the Kentucky Oaks affair is run at 1 1/16 miles on the dirt for three-year-old fillies and has historically attracted some of the top fillies in training. Champion Monomoy Girl used the Ashland as her final prep before eclipsing the 2018 Kentucky Oaks (G1).

Three other graded races will be contested on Saturday --\$300,000 Madison Stakes (G1); \$250,000 Shakertown Stakes (G2); and the \$250,000 Commonwealth Stakes (G3).

A pair of graded races will take place on Sunday, April 7 to cap a blockbuster opening weekend. Sophomore fillies will travel one-mile on the green in the \$200,000 Appalachian Stakes (G2). Also on the card is the \$150,000 Beaumont Stakes (G3), for three-year-old fillies running about seven furlongs on the main strip.

The second weekend of racing lacks the quantity of the prior week, though the quality is still in abundance. Friday, April 12 features the \$300,000 Maker's 46 Mile (G1). This one-mile turf event is one of the top early-season races for mile turf specialists and a sizable field is expected this campaign.

On Saturday, April 13 four total stakes races will take place, with a trio of those being of the graded variety. Fillies and mares will go 1 1/16 miles on the green in the always highly competitive \$350,000 Jenny Wiley Stakes (G1).

The \$200,000 Lexington Stakes (G3) is on the Jenny Wiley undercard. This event is rapidly growing in popularity and is a key spot for horses hoping to earn additional points on the Road to the Kentucky Derby. The \$200,000 Ben Ali Stakes (G3) and \$100,000 Giant's Causeway Stakes are the other pair of black-type contests on the day.

The closing day feature \$150,000 Bewitch Stakes (G3) on April, 26. Fillies and mares will travel 1 ½ miles on the turf to conclude the exciting spring meeting.

Keeneland offers high-quality racing for all types of horses, whether it be on the turf or the main oval. The picturesque venue features full fields with competitive betting events, as well as a strong purse structure. It's a must see for all racing fans!



KEENELAND TRAINERS TO WATCH by John Mucciolo

The sensational spring meeting at Keeneland gets underway on Thursday, April 6. A total of 18 graded events will headline the fine racing at the Lexington, Kentucky venue, with eight of those to be contested during opening weekend.

Keeneland always attracts many of the top horses, jockeys and conditioners from around the country. Below I tabbed a handful of trainers that could be successful at the meeting.

Wesley Ward – The king of the juveniles tied for his second straight trainers' title in the spring of 2018, saddling 13 winners. While Ward is capable of sending out a winner in any type of race, he will be more than prominent in the two-year-old dashes, and he has also been strong with turf sprinters. Expect more of the same this campaign.

Brad Cox – He tied with Ward last spring with a baker's dozen of first-place finishers. The conditioner of champion Monomoy Girl is far from a 'one-trick pony', as he has a deep stable and wins at a high-percentage rate. His local go-to pilot, Florent Geroux, was the leading jockey here in 2019. That duo will have success once again at Keeneland.

Graham Motion – The expert horseman doesn't generally saddle enough starters to vie for a trainers' title, however, his horses are often very live at Keeneland. Motion is a dual-threat conditioner with his pupils capable of running on either surface. We can bank on at least one longshot winner coming from this barn in the spring.

Todd Pletcher – The Hall-of-Fame conditioner had a robust fall meeting here with nine tallies. Pletcher will not send out an abundance of horses at the meet, but each one will merit consideration when they run. He has been a leading trainer on five occasions at Keeneland and is always prominent in the stakes races.

Mike Maker – Owners Ken and Sarah Ramsey have won a staggering 21 owners' titles at Keeneland and Mike Maker is a conditioner who saddles many of their charges. Maker finished one behind Pletcher in the fall and he has an edge on many of his conditioning counterparts on numbers alone. Assume that he will be at or near the top of the trainers' race at the end of the stanza.



KEENELAND HORSES TO WATCH by John Mucciolo

Keeneland will kick-off its spring meet on Thursday, April 4. The exciting Lexington, Kentucky spring staple will play host to 18 graded stakes races during the three-week run, with a bevy of big races on opening weekend. I have tabbed a few horses to watch at the upcoming meeting.

Win Win Win – This talented stakes winner finished third as the favorite in the Tampa Bay Derby (G2) and will take aim on the Blue Grass Stakes (G2) on Saturday. The Michael Trombetta pupil was wide throughout last time and he could stamp himself as a serious Kentucky Derby (G1) contender with a top showing in the Blue Grass. The Hat Trick colt will retain jockey Irad Ortiz, Jr.

Shamrock Rose – Champion filly parlayed a win in the Raven Run Stakes (G2) here in the fall into an upset victory in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint (G1). Mark Casse trainee was a fine third in the Azeri Stakes (G2) most recently behind two of the top horses in training, which should set her up well for her Keeneland return. The daughter of First Dude is the headliner of the Madison Stakes (G1) on Saturday.

Jaywalk – Champion Two-Year-Old Filly of 2018 failed to fire in her seasonal debut when fourth in the Davona Dale Stakes (G2), though she will look to make amends

in Saturday's Ashland Stakes (G1). The John Servistrained daughter of Cross Traffic had a dominant juvenile campaign that was capped by a 5 ½-length romp in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (G1). She posted a strong half-mile on the Keeneland main surface on Sunday.

Restless Rider – Kenny McPeek trainee ran her best race here at two with a clear tally in the Alcibiades Stakes (G1). The Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (G1) runner-up is unraced in 2019 but is training swiftly, and she is expected to fire a big one off the layoff in her lone prep for the Kentucky Oaks (G1). The consistently good daughter of Distorted Humor concluded her two-year-old season with a 6-3-3-0 line and more than \$780,000 in earnings.

Limousine Liberal – Ben Colebrook trainee is a fan favorite in Kentucky and he is showing sharp morning drills in anticipation of his comeback. Unraced since coming home in fifth in the Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1), the son of Successful Appeal will once again contest the Commonwealth Stakes (G3) and the third time might be the charm. The six-year-old gelding finished third in the dash in 2017, and improved to second in the 2018 edition.
