

LECOMTE STAKES CONTENDERS

MIDNIGHT BOURBON



One of the more experienced in the field but well held in two earlier preps.

ARABIAN PRINCE



Third in the Kentucky Jockey Club and one of the few here with competitive stakes experience.

BEEP BEEP



Drew off to win debut well going seven-eighths; can threaten for a share or more if he goes.

PROXY



Godolphin homebred still a bit green but is 2-for-2 in New Orleans with plenty more potential. High to face winners for the first time; improvement required.

REGULAR GUY



Held on in slowly-run maiden over the Fair Grounds strip; improvement needed.

GAME DAY PLAY



Eked out a stakes win against Red N Wild, but a longshot in this more difficult spot.

SANTA CRUISER



Third to division champ in debut and graduated stepping up to a mile. Should improve.

RED N WILD



Multiple stakes-placed colt a distant third in softer Springboard Mile; won for a tag two back.

MANOR HOUSE



Dominated maiden foes at Laurel, but tough ask first out against winners if he goes.

MANDOLOUN



Winner of both starts in Kentucky and future looks bright as he stretches out for the first time.

DYN O MITE



Enters on a two-race win streak, but narrow allowance victory was relatively slow.
